Supporting Document Deadline

All required supporting documents (all transcripts, credential evaluations, letters of recommendation, and test scores if applicable) must be submitted and received to your application no later than two weeks after the deadline.

Doctoral Programs

All doctoral programs have a **December 1** deadline, except for the PhD in Clinical Investigation, which has a **March 1** deadline.

Master's Programs

Master's Programs without a December 1 deadline review on a rolling basis until the designated date. Early submission of your applications and all supporting documents is highly encouraged.

Residency Applicants

Residency applicants should submit their application no later than October 15.

Combined Bachelor's/Master's Applicants

All Johns Hopkins University undergraduate students interested in the Bachelor's/ MHA, Bachelor's/MHS, or Bachelor's/MSPH programs can apply during the summer between their junior and senior years. The application deadline is July 1.

The departments of Environmental Health and Engineering; Health, Behavior and Society; and Mental Health allow JHU seniors to apply to their respective Bachelor's/ Master's degrees during the beginning of their senior year until October 15 once the application reopens in mid-August.

The deadline for the Master of Health Administration, the MHS and MSPH from the Department of Health Policy and Management, and the MSPH from the Department of International Health is extended to February 1.
