Reflects the group’s shared mission and vision

Has data supporting its efficacy of the policy			
Has a champion(s) – elected official or public figure			
Has a significant impact – short term; long term			
Politically feasible			
Financially feasible			

Legally feasible			
Procedurally or administratively feasible to implement			
Addresses social, economic, and environmental equity			
Opposition is limited or insignificant – political or public			
Easily communicated to the public and policy makers			
There are logical partners and an ample constituency support
