- Firearms were the leading cause of death among children and teens ages 1-17 in 2022.
- In 2021, there were at least 42 domestic violence-related homicides in Wisconsin. 64% were by firearm.<sup>1</sup>


## Firearms are used in the majority of homicides and suicides
