- · Young Black males ages 15-34 make up nearly 3% of the state's population but accounted for 41% of all gun homicide deaths in 2022.
- In 2021, there were at least 150 domestic violence-related homicides in Tennessee. 75% were by firearm.1


## Firearms are used in the majority of homicides and suicides





Gun violence costs Tennesseans \$16 billion per year in 2022. This amounts to \$2,269 per person.<sup>2</sup>
